39th Annual Karl J. Boehret Surf Fishing Tournament in Sea Isle City, NJ on May 15, 2021

This event will be a team and individual tournament. Team (6 fisherpersons) registration is \$60.00. Individual registration is \$10.00. Registration will be via mail or email. Registration form and checks can be sent to **DVSAA**, Jane Jefferys, 24 Lake Vista Dr., CMCH, NJ 08210 or via email: jandjefferys@comcast.net. 609-624-1427. We will need the names, sex and age of youth for all team members so Jane can fill out the score sheets prior to tournament. Team captain **only** will go to registration at the beach entrance at 85th Street to pick up score sheets and give registration money if not sent by mail. Position numbers will be pulled Friday night to speed things up (and filmed). Covid 19 restrictions apply, please maintain 6' distance and masks must be worn if less than 6'. Suggest that "gaiters" be worn.

Beach buggy permits have been waived for the tournament. Only vehicles with 4-wheel drive are permitted on the beach. Prevailing Association of Surf Angling Clubs tournament rules will be observed.

Awards will be mailed to winners or given out at Surf n'Land tourney May 22, on the beach.

Covid 19 protocols MUST be followed at all times. There will be locals on the beach so please respect distancing and mask protocols .

The beach entrance and headquarters is at 85th St. The other beach entrance is at 75th St.

There is a rest room at 85th St., on JFK Blvd. south side close to Landis Ave. and another at 93rd St. right before the bridge on the right side of Landis Ave. in parking lot.

There is no gas station on the island. Wawa with gas is at the corner of Sea Isle Blvd. and Route 9, which is 1 block from the Parkway on and off ramps. There is an air pump in the Wawa parking lot. The Parkway rest area is one half mile past the on ramp from SIC Blvd. Gas is available here.

Bait: Across from Wawa on SIC Blvd at Rt 9 is Boulevard Bait and Tackle, 535 Sea Isle Blvd, Ocean View, 08230

Bait: SI Bait & Tackle, 42nd & Park Ave, 4111 Park Rd, SIC 08243 across from SIC Community Lodge.

Wawa at 37th and Landis Ave. (no gas).

Coffee, donuts and lunch will NOT be available to participants this year.

Waivers will be handed out with score sheets to be signed on beach and collected by judges when score sheets are signed.

At 12:30 PM when fishing ends, all captains are asked to check their score sheets because after you leave the beach, the scoring will stand. All participants should leave at this time and results will be posted online.

REGISTRATION:

Captain Name, sex, ASAC member club or not, Youth age (14-17) Youth – (5-13), Youth Assisted . Other team members. You can email or call Jane (jandjefferys@comcast.net, 609-624-1427) as late at 7 PM Friday, May 14, so she can fill out the score sheets. Waver given out with score sheets to be signed on beach by team members on the beach and returned to judges at break-change positions. Registration money can be paid when captain is picking up score sheets.

Calcuttas must be signed up for prior to start of tourney. Call or email Jane if you want to enter Calcuttas. Money can be sent with registration or paid the morning of the tourney.

New ASAC Rules:

Bluefish minimum is 12", per state regs. only 3 are to be in fisherpersons possession at any time, this includes blues saved for bait.

Senior assist is a permanent rule. All anglers must cast for themselves except for 13 and under **assisted** youths & disabled adults, who must have requested casting assistance before registration from tournament chairman & an ASAC official.

For 2021 only: Sharks are the **only** 1 point fish. All other fish that are 10" and larger, and conform to their state and federal minimum size, shall score points based on their length. Skates and rays do **not** count for any points. shall score points based on their length over 10" will count eg: Sea Robins, Blowfish, Perch, Spot, and Porgies, etc.
